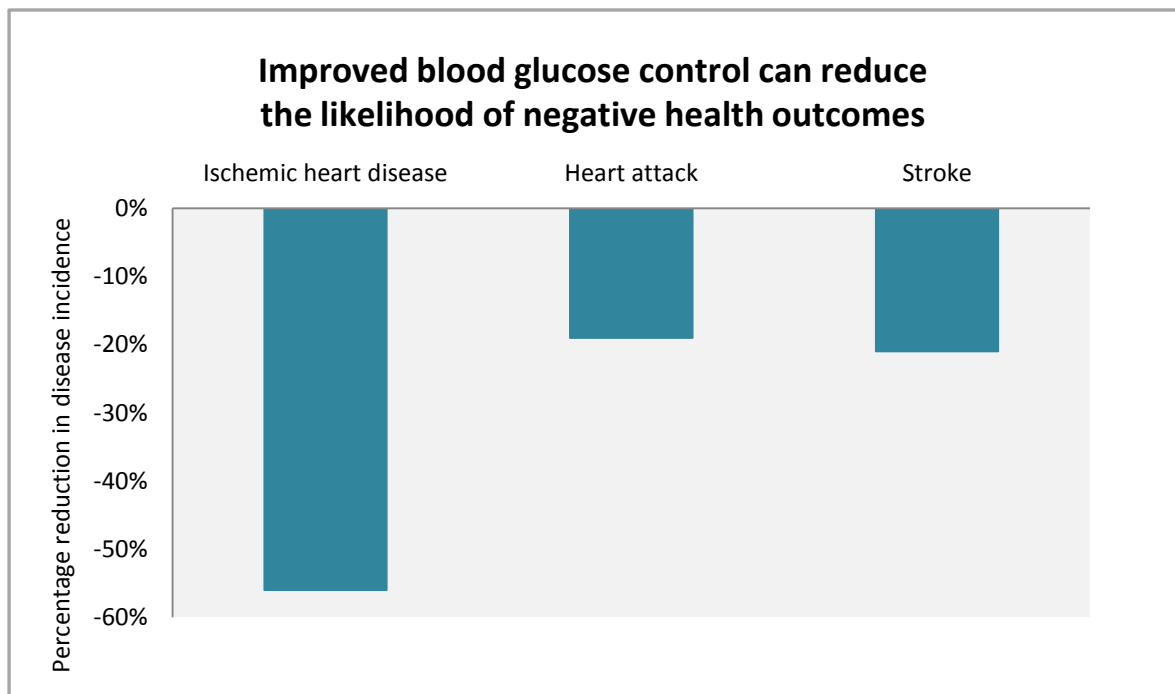
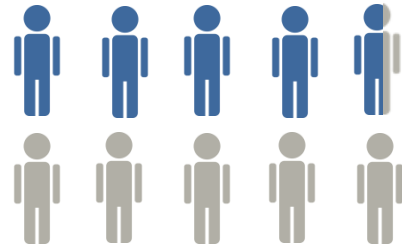


Better Management of Diabetes Saves the United States Money

Projected total annual savings to United States (U.S.) Medicaid from better management of diabetes

Nearly **5 in 10** Medicaid beneficiaries living with diabetes do not have their blood glucose levels under control.



In the U.S., better control of diabetes can reduce the onset of ischemic heart disease by **up to 34 percent**.



With better diabetes control, U.S. Medicaid could save an average of **\$985** per beneficiary.
