


Better Management of Diabetes Saves the United States Money

\$4.1 Billion

Projected total annual savings to United States (U.S.) Medicaid from better management of diabetes

Nearly 5 in 10 Medicaid beneficiaries living with diabetes do not have their blood glucose levels under control.







In the U.S., better control of diabetes can reduce the onset of ischemic heart disease by up to 34 percent.



With better diabetes control, U.S. Medicaid could save an average of \$985 per beneficiary.
