In addition, more than **16 MILLION** informal caregivers provide:

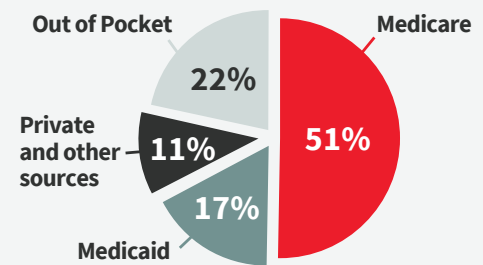


**18.6 BILLION HOURS** of unpaid care conservatively worth **\$244 BILLION** (2019)
